Rise helps students: (1) prepare for college-level math and science courses, (2) become independent learners, and (3) gain academic self-confidence. Program participation results in improved grades and helps tutees see college as a viable option, as well as empowers them to view themselves as future scientists and engineers.

Through tailored instruction and focused individual support, the Caltech Y is bridging race- and income-based achievement gaps and inspiring a new generation of underrepresented students to pursue careers in STEM.
